Dear Cambridge Village of Apex Residents and Families,

We are aware of the COVID-19 outbreak that has been discovered at UNC Rex Rehabilitation and Nursing Care Center of Apex that is located next door.

We have not had any resident in our community return from a visit at Rex Rehab since early February.

I want to reiterate to residents and families all of our visitor restrictions, that are still in place.

Access to the community is still limited to residents, staff, and approved family/medical caregivers. Our visitor policies have not changed with the Wake County stay-at-home order being lifted.

- We are requiring that any resident that is being discharged from a hospital or skilled rehabilitation facility self-quarantines in their apartment for 14 days upon return to the community.
- It is not safe practice for a resident to leave and visit family and return to the community at this time.

Staff, residents, and families have all worked hard together to keep our community free of COVID-19 to this point. Non-Essential visitation at this time is potentially dangerous to the health and safety of ALL of our residents.

We will continue to update everyone as more information becomes available.
