Dear Cambridge Village of Apex Residents and Families,

Due to the growing nature and spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) in the United States, Cambridge Village has decided to modify specific services to decrease the potential for the virus impacting our community and our vulnerable population. Thursday, March 12th Governor Cooper called for cancelling or postponing all gatherings of over 100 people due to COVID-19. We will be adhering to this and limiting group activities to 50 or less. We strongly encourage you to be prepared in your home with supplies including food, water, toiletries and cleaning supplies. Have a plan in place with your family if you should need additional assistance or transportation.

The CDC has made it clear that adults 65 and over are at a higher risk for contracting the virus. The Governor of North Carolina issued a State of Emergency on Thursday advising adults 65 and over to avoid gatherings of over 100 people. Because of this, we are making changes, effective immediately to the following departments:

Restaurant:

- Starting Saturday, March 14th the restaurant will only be serving meals to go. The café and pub will be closed until further notice. A copy of the menu for Saturday, Sunday, and Monday is attached. The menu for the next week will be available on Monday.
- Meal Times:
 - Monday-Saturday
 - Lunch: 11:30am-1:30pm
 - Dinner: 4:30pm-6:30pm
 - Sunday
 - Brunch: 11:00am-1:00pm
- Residents will order and pick-up meals at the to-go stand in the restaurant. Deliveries will be available via phone.

Transportation:

- **Effective immediately:** scheduled activities/events outside the community will be cancelled for the month of March & April. This includes lunches/dinners out.
- **Effective immediately:** Personal transportation will only be available for doctor's appointments and pharmacy trips.
- **Friday, 3/13's Walmart trips will be the last Walmart trips for the time being.**

Lifestyle:

- **Entertainment inside the community will be limited to gatherings of 50 or less people**
- All scheduled group outings that use transportation from Cambridge Village are postponed effective immediately.
- All entertainers coming into the community have been cancelled for the next week.
- Additional activities and entertainers will be scheduled to make up for cancelled outings

Wellness Center

- Until further notice, our Wellness Center will not be open to outside members.
- Wellness classes will continue at this time.

Visitor Restrictions:

- **We discourage visitors unless necessary.** All visitors must sign in at reception located at the main entrance.
 - Main entrance doors will be locked on Saturdays and Sundays. Community issued fobs will work. All guests will need to be greeted by a receptionist or resident and must sign in.
- **Visitors must be healthy.**
 - Do not visit if you feel sick or have symptoms of a cold, flu, respiratory infection or another illness. If you exhibit signs of being sick, we will kindly ask you to leave the community.

Additional hand sanitizer stations and Lysol wipes have been placed around the community. If you are using a common area, please make sure to wipe down the space with proper cleaning products after each use.

Our goal is to be proactive during this time and stay ahead of the virus. Restrictions are subject to change at any time. We will continue to keep you informed as decisions are made.
